Notice to Exhibitors

This trial is being held under the Agility Association of Canada, Inc. (AAC) Rules and Regulations. Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of the AAC Rules and Regulations, including but not limited to the following:

- This trial is open to all dogs being at least 18 months of age, including purebred and non-purebred, except bitches in season, dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness that may affect the dog's physical or mental performance or dogs exhibiting signs of aggression towards people or other dogs.
- Jump heights will be 6", 10", 16", 22", 26".
- There shall be NO REFUNDS for entries withdrawn after the closing date, except for bitches that come into season. There shall be no refunds in the event a dog and/or handler are dismissed from competition, regardless of the reason for such dismissal.
- All competing dogs must be registered with the Agility Association of Canada by having an AAC Dog Identification Card. Dogs without an AAC ID number will NOT receive credit for any legs earned. All dogs must have a valid AAC ID Card before they compete.
- Agility obstacles will be chosen from those described in the AAC Rulebook.
- An electronic timer will be used.
- The trial's organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
- Move ups from titles earned on Saturday to Sunday's runs will be permitted if brought to the attention of the trial secretary before the end of the trial on Saturday.
- For Exhibition Only runs will not be allowed except where a dog is measured up to the next height division, in which case the dog may run at the entered height For Exhibition Only.
- Individual confirmations will not be mailed. Confirmations will be posted at www.macdogs.com approximately 7 days before the trial and updated as needed.
- Breed Specific Legislation is in effect in all of Ontario. A Pit Bull Terrier, a Staffordshire Bull Terrier, an American Staffordshire Terrier, an American Pit Bull Terrier, or a dog that has an appearance of a "Pit Bull" is not allowed to compete in this trial. For more information see www.doglegislationcouncilcanada.org/bill132qa2.pdf. Any Pit Bull as defined above, must be leashed and muzzled on the property.

Trial Site & Facilities

The trial is at Fleetwood Farms, 9282 Elviage Road, London, just west of Byron (see the MAC website for map). The trial is on a dirt floor. We are extremely fortunate to have the use of this venue. To ensure that we may be allowed to use this facility again, please abide by the following guidelines:

- No dogs or people are permitted in the stables or paddock areas or anywhere near the horses
- Clean up after your dog
- Use the waste receptacles
- NO SMOKING in or near any of the buildings or their entrances
- Park only in the designated areas
- Dogs are to be kept on leash (flexi's allowed) when on the property
- A separate indoor crating area is available. There is no crating in the arena.
- Food vendor on-site
