

Fleetwood Farms Rules & Site Info

Please refer to the sketch below for further clarification

1. ENTRY / EXIT TO FLEETWOOD FARMS (9282 Elviage Drive, London, ON)

Entry to Fleetwood Farms is through the stone gates on the east side of the house. The agility arena is at the back, behind the house, horse arena and large garage on your left. See the map below. Please drive SLOWLY while on the property and give way to pedestrians, horses and dogs.

2. PARKING

Parking is allowed on the grass around the agility arena and on the gravel parking area in front of the arena. The gravel area in front of the indoor crating building must be kept clear for loading & unloading only, so there is no parking in that area. Please do not park too close to the arena entry/exit areas.

3. CRATING

There is plenty of indoor crating (heated in the winter) as shown on the map. As well, outdoor crating is allowed anywhere in the vicinity of the agility arena as long as it's not too close to the arena entry/exit areas. There is no crating allowed in the agility arena.

4. CAMPING

Campers should set up in the grass area behind the agility arena. Campers must be back on the grounds by 10pm as the main gates are locked at that time. Campers can set up after 6pm on Friday and are required to leave by 8pm on Sunday.

5. OFF LIMITS

All horses, horse paddocks and all buildings other than the agility arena are off limits to all agility participants, guests, spectators and dogs.

6. DOGS ON LEASH & PICKING UP AFTER YOUR DOG

Unless in the warm up area, in the agility ring, or swimming in the pond, your dog(s) must be kept on leash. You are welcome to walk your dogs anywhere that is not off limits. Please stoop and scoop after your dog (regardless of where you are on the property) and dispose of the bagged poop in the designated barrels.

7. GARBAGE

Please place all garbage in the appropriate containers only. Please place only recycling materials (glass, cans and plastic) in the clearly marked recycling containers. Please place all other garbage (including bagged dog poop) in the clearly marked general garbage containers.
